Beth: 'Mike? 'He's out there?

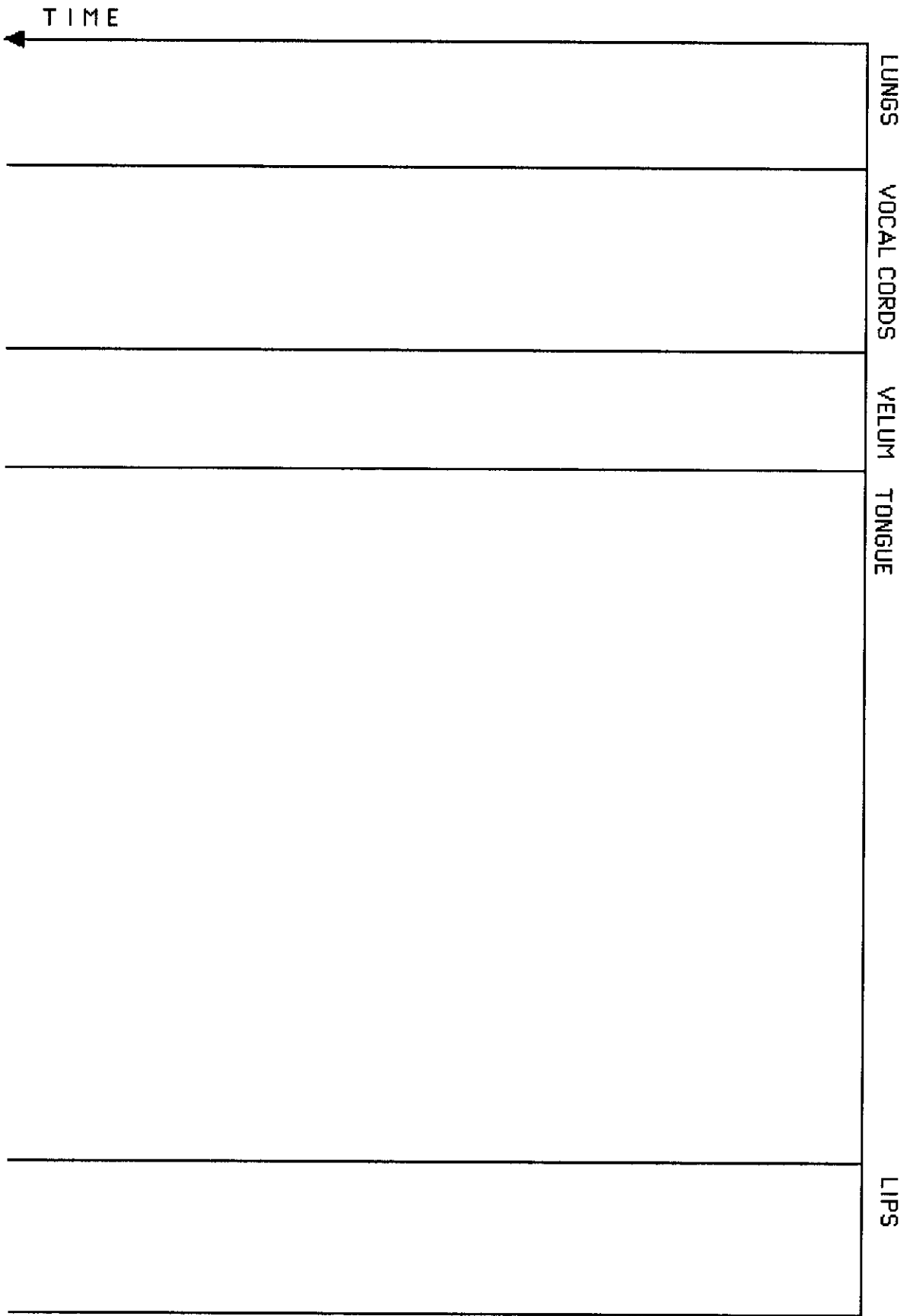
