- 2. "Alice Munro's short story 'Dimensions' is a study of gender roles, which shows that very little has improved in terms of women's emancipation over the last three decades." Discuss the story in light of this statement.
- 3. Compare and contrast Cormac McCarthy's novel *The Road* and Sean Penn's film *Into the Wild*. You should focus on such elements as structure, the main characters' journeys, and the presentation of nature and civilization.
