ANSWER ONLY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- 1. Discuss the themes of Arundhati Roy's *The God of Small Things*. Your discussion may include the following themes (as well as others): society and social class; gender roles; love and the "love laws"; and "the small things" (and "the big things").
- 2. Explore the range of women in Caryl Churchill's *Top Girls* and discuss the extent to which they speak to a modern audience.
- 3. Describe the major characters in Annie Proulx' "Brokeback Mountain", and how the relationships between them illuminate the themes that are relevant today. Your essay should either consider the short story only, or both the short story and the film. (extract included)

Extract from Annie Proulx' "Brokeback Mountain":

The shirt seemed heavy until he saw there was another shirt inside it, the sleeves carefully worked down inside Jack's sleeves. It was his own plaid shirt, lost, he'd thought, long ago in some damn laundry, his dirty shirt, the pocket ripped, buttons missing, stolen by Jack and hidden here inside Jack's own shirt, the pair like two skins, one inside the other, two in one. He pressed his face into the fabric and breathed in slowly through his mouth and nose, hoping for the faintest smoke and mountain sage and salty sweet stink of Jack but there was no real scent, only the memory of it, the imagined power of Brokeback Mountain of which nothing was left but what he held in his hands.
