Write an essay on ONE of the following two topics.

1. Give an interpretation of Carol Ann Duffy's "Little Red-Cap"
2. Select one other poem of your own choice and give an interpretation of it. If you opt for this topic, you must get the choice of poem approved by the teacher at the latest Friday 26 September.

Your essay should be 1,000–2,000 words long and should be submitted on Fronter (folder "Assignment 2: Obligatory 40%") by Tuesday 8 October at 23:59. If you use secondary literature, make sure you credit your sources.

Remember to submit the essay in a word format.

The **title** of your essay should be **your full name and the numeral 2:**

3. In Genesis, God gives man "dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth" (I: 26). To what extent has this become problematic in recent years?

Write an essay of 500–1,000 words. Use Times New Roman, 12 pt, double shift ('dobbel linjeavstand').

Remember the *process* of writing: brainstorm, outline, drafting. We shall not only be discussing the final result, but we shall be focusing on the process of writing as well.
